





Bristol is a beautiful city, a couple of hours away **(0)** (in, <u>from</u>, near) London. But you cannot visit Bristol without spending some time **(a)** (at, from, in) its central area, so wandering **(b)** (across, around, along) the Old City is sure to happen. The Old City of Bristol is the heart of the city and as the name suggests, it is full of historical buildings.

There is a lot crammed into this city, which makes it an area worth exploring. While walking (c) (over, into, along) its cobbled streets, you cannot miss interesting landmarks like the remains of Bristol Castle.
