

Authorisation Examination for the Application of Authorisation of a Service Provider for Electrical Installations as per Electrical Installations Regulations (S.L.545.24) – July 2026

1. The Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations notify that the Authorisation A and B written examinations will be held between **Tuesday 30th June 2026** and **Friday 3rd July 2026** to enable successful candidates to apply for the issue of Authorisations 'A' and 'B' at the Regulator for Energy and Water Services (REWS) as stipulated in the Regulator for Energy and Water Services Act (Cap. 545) and Electrical Installations Regulations (S.L.545.24).
2. The Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations also notify that the **Practical Test and Interview** in connection with the Authorisation of a service provider for electrical installation 'A' and 'B' will be held between **Wednesday 9th September 2026** and **Wednesday 30th September 2026**.

4. The examination will be held as follows:

(a) Authorisation 'A' Examination – Single Phase

Paper I (Written)

Examination Duration: 2½ hours
Marks: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

Paper II (Written)

Examination Duration: 3 hours
Marks: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

Practical Test and Interview

Practical Test and Interview Duration: 1 hour
Practical test: Mark (Max. 70%)
Interview : Mark (Max. 30%)
Global mark: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

(b) Authorisation 'B' Examination – Three Phase

Paper I (Written)

Examination Duration: 2½ hours
Marks: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

Paper II (Written)

Examination Duration: 3 hours
Marks: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

Practical Test and Interview

Practical Test and Interview Duration: 1 hour

Practical test: Mark (Max. 70%)

Interview: Mark (Max. 30%)

Global mark: 100% (Max.), Pass mark 50%

5. Candidates must pass **both written papers** in the same examination session to be eligible to sit for the Practical Test and Interview.
6. Candidates who pass both written papers but fail or are absent for the Practical Test and Interview, may reattempt only the Practical Test and Interview within a period of **two (2) years** from the written examination session.
7. To be able to apply with REWS for Authorisation 'A' or for Authorisation 'B', candidates must obtain a pass mark in **both** Paper I and Paper II together with a pass mark in the Practical Test and Interview.

9. Late applications will not be considered.
10. The Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations reserve the right to take disciplinary action against any candidate found guilty of misconduct or breach of the **Instructions to Candidates** included with the timetable sent to each candidate.

The Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations reserve the right to annul the examination and/or disqualify a candidate if any irregularity is detected at any stage of the examination. Such annulment and/or disqualification may apply to the full examination even if the irregularity is limited to a single paper.
