**Sejha għall-ingaġġ ta' Suldati fil-Forzi Armati ta' Malta (Forza Regolari)****Call for the enlistment of Soldiers in the Armed Forces of Malta (Regular Force)**

*Suldat Regolari, Suldat Regolari bi sfond tekniku u Suldat Regolari bi sfond mużikali*

*Regular Soldier, Regular Soldier with technical background and Regular Soldier with a musical background*

1. Ir-Reġistratur tal-Eżamijiet u l-Forzi Armati ta' Malta (FAM) jistiednu l-applikazzjonijiet għall-ingaġġ ta' suldati sabiex iservu fil-Forza Regolari tal-Forzi Armati ta' Malta.

1. The Registrar of Examinations, together with the Armed Forces of Malta (AFM), invites applications for the enlistment of soldiers to serve in the Regular Force of the Armed Forces of Malta.

**2. Rekwiżiti ta' Eligibbiltà****2. Eligibility Requirements****2.1 Rekwiżiti Ġenerali****2.1 General Requirements**

L-applikanti:

Applicants must:

a. għandhom ikunu ċittadini Maltin;

a. be Maltese citizens;

b. għandhom ikunu għalqu t-tminax-il (18) sena sal-31 ta' Diċembru, 2026, u ma jkunux għalqu t-tletin (30) sena sat-30 ta' April, 2027;

b. be eighteen (18) years of age by 31st December, 2026, but have not reached the age of thirty (30) by 30th April, 2027;

c. għandhom ikunu ta' karattru morali tajjeb;

c. be of good moral character;

d. għandhom ikunu kapaċi jgħumu;

d. be able to swim;

e. għandhom ikunu twal tal-anqas: 1.57m fil-każ tal-irġiel u 1.52m fil-każ tan-nisa, u ta' piż aċċettabbli pparagunat mat-tul;

e. be not less than the minimum height required: 1.57m for males and 1.52m for females, and of acceptable body weight in proportion to height;

f. m'għandux ikollhom tattoos eċċessivi, u żgur mhux fuq il-wiċċ, l-għonq u kwalunkwe parti tal-id, jew tattoos li huma offensivi, estremisti, indiċenti jew razzisti fuq kwalunkwe parti tal-ġisem;

f. not sport excessive tattoos, and definitely not on face and neck and any part of the hand, or tattoos that are offensive, extremist, indecent or racist on any part of the body.

**2.2 Kwalifiki Mehtieġa (suġġetti ewlenin)****2.2 Required Qualifications (core subjects)**

L-applikanti għandhom jissodisfaw mill-inqas WAHDA minn dawn li ġejjin għal kull suġġett, jiġifieri l-Malti, il-Lingwa Ingliża, u l-Matematika:

Applicants must satisfy at least ONE of the below for each subject, namely Maltese, English Language, and Mathematics:

a. ikollhom ċertifikati f'Livell 2 tal-MQF, jiġifieri:

a. be in possession of a pass at MQF Level 2, that is:

i. jiksbu minimu ta' Grad 7 fil-każ ta' eżamijiet ta' ĊES (SEC); jew

i. obtain a pass at least at Grade 7 in the case of SEC examinations; or

ii. jiksbu minimu ta' Grad E jew 3 fil-każ ta' eżamijiet ta' Edexcel (London); jew

ii. obtain a pass at least at Grade E or 3 in the case of Edexcel (London) examinations; or

iii. jiksbu 'pass' fis-suġġett/i rekwiżit/i fil-Keyskills Certificate bħala parti minn kwalifika kompluta tal-MCAST, dment li l-livell tas-suġġett/i kkonċernati ikun mill-inqas Livell 2 tal-MQF;

iii. obtain a pass in the required subject/s in the Keyskills Certificate as part of a completed MCAST qualification, provided that the level obtained in the subjects is at least at MQF Level 2;

iv. ċertifikati oħra rikonoxxuti ta' livell komparabbli.

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b. ikollhom kwalifika rikonoxxuta mhux inqas minn Livell 2 al-MQF, jew Secondary School Certificate and Profiling Qualification f'Livell 2 tal-MQF li ngħata mhux qabel l-2015. Fiż-żewġ każijiet, il-komponenti tal-Malti, il-Lingwa Ingliża u l-Matematika għandhom ikunu inklużi bħala core subjects f'Livell 2 tal-MQF;

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c. jgħaddu b'suċċess eżami tal-kitba fis-suġġett/i mitluba (il-Malti, il-Lingwa Ingliża u l-Matematika) li jitmexxew mir-Registratur tal-Eżamijiet u l-Bord tal-Eżamijiet Pubbliċi Lokali bħala parti minn dan il-Proċess tal-Għażla.

Kwalifiki li huma ta' livell ogħla minn dak rikjest hawn fuq, jiġu aċċettati għal skopijiet ta' eliġibbiltà sakemm dawn jissodisfaw is-suġġetti mitluba.

Applikanti li kienu għaddew mill-eżamijiet tal-kitba li kienu parti minn sejhiet preċedenti tal-FAM maħruġa għall-ingaġġ ta' suldati fil-Forzi Armati ta' Malta (Forza Regolari) mill-2013 'l hawn, ikunu eżentati milli jerġgħu jpoġġu għall-eżamijiet rispettivi.

Il-predictive assessments mis-sessjoni ewlenija tal-MATSEC tal-2020 jiġu aċċettati dment li jindikaw tal-anqas Livell 2 tal-MQF fis-suġġetti rikjesti;

Applikanti li għandhom kwalifiki tal-MCAST u li ngħataw 'Compensatory Pass' jew 'Administrative Pass' f'xi suġġett/i partikolari jkunu meħtieġa jpoġġu għall-eżamijiet tal-kitba korrispondenti, sakemm ma jissodisfawx waħda mill-klawżoli l-oħra fis-suġġett/i kkonċernat/i.

2.3 Rekwiziti addizzjonali (jekk qed tapplika taħt stream speċifika biss)

a. Suldati Regolari bi sfond tekniku:

għandhom jissodisfaw ir-rekwiziti ta' kwalifiki msemmija f'taqsimha 2.2. hawn fuq, u jkollhom Diploma BTEC/MCAST (Livell 3 tal-MQF jew ogħla) jew kwalifika ekwivalenti rikonoxxuta.

b. Suldati Regolari bi sfond mużikali:

għandhom jissodisfaw ir-rekwiziti ta' kwalifiki msemmija f'taqsimha 2.2. hawn fuq, u jkun mużikalment profiċjenti fi strument wiehied jew iktar.

2.4 Dispożizzjonijiet speċjali u prijorità

iv. other recognised certificates at a comparable level.

AND/OR

b. be in possession of a recognised qualification at MQF Level 2, or a Secondary School Certificate and Profiling qualification at MQF Level 2 awarded not earlier than 2015. In both cases, components in Maltese, English Language and Mathematics must be included as core subjects at MQF Level 2;

AND/OR

c. be successful in a written examination in the required subject/s (Maltese, English Language and Mathematics) conducted by the Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations as part of this Selection Process.

Qualifications higher than those required will be accepted for eligibility purposes, provided they meet the subject requirements.

Applicants who have passed written examinations forming part of previous AFM calls issued for enlistment of soldiers in the Armed Forces of Malta (Regular Force) from 2013 onwards will be exempted from sitting for the respective examinations.

Predictive assessments from the 2020 main MATSEC session indicating at least MQF Level 2 in the required subjects will be accepted.

Applicants holding MCAST qualifications who have been awarded a 'Compensatory Pass' or an 'Administrative Pass' in any particular subject/s will be required to sit for the corresponding written examinations, unless they satisfy one of the other clauses in the subject/s in question.

2.3 Additional requirements (only if applying under a specific stream)

a. Regular Soldier with technical background:

must meet the qualifications requirements specified in section 2.2. above, and hold a BTEC/MCAST Diploma (MQF Level 3 or higher) or an equivalent recognised qualification.

b. Regular Soldier with a musical background:

must meet the qualifications requirements specified in section 2.2. above, and be musically proficient in one or more instruments.

2.4 Special provisions and priority

a. Il-FAM jistgħu jikkunsidraw l-ingaġġ ta' applikanti li ma jilhqux ir-rekwiżiti ta' kwalifiki msemija f'taqsima 2.2. hawn fuq, madankollu dawn ir-rekwiżiti jridu jinkisbu sabiex wieħed ikun jista' javvanza fil-grad.

b. Persunal li ma jissodisfax ir-rekwiżiti ta' kwalifiki msemija f'taqsima 2.2. hawn fuq, ma jkunx eliġibbli għall-promozzjoni sakemm ma jkissibhomx b'suċċess.

c. Tingħata prijorità lill-applikanti li jissodisfaw ir-rekwiżiti speċifikati fil-taqsima 2.2. ta' din is-sejha.

3. Verifika u Validazzjoni (kwalifiki meħtieġa, ċertifikati u rikonoxximent fejn applikabbli)

L-applikanti għandhom jipprovdu kopji ċari skennjati ta' ċertifikati u l-paġni kollha tat-traskritti mitluba, inkluża d-dikjarazzjoni tal-Livell MQF fejn applikabbli. Għall-ekwivalenza tal-kwalifiki, irreferi għall-paragrafu 9.4 (a) sa (e).

### 3.1 Eżami tal-kitba (fejn applikabbli)

a. Din il-parti tapplika biss għal applikanti li ma jissodisfawx il-kwalifiki meħtieġa u li jridu jpoġġu għal eżami/jiet tal-kitba skont ir-rekwiżiti ta' eliġibbiltà.

L-eżamijiet bil-kitba:

i. jitmexxew mir-Reġistratur tal-Eżamijiet u l-Bord tal-Eżamijiet Pubbliċi Lokali;

ii. huma f'format ta' għażla multipla;

iii. għandhom ħin allokat ta' siegħa u nofs għal kull karta.

Kull karta tal-eżami għorr massimu ta' 100 marka. Il-pass mark f'kull karta hija ta' 50 marka.

Non-scientific calculators jistgħu jintużaw waqt l-eżami tal-Matematika.

b. Dati:

i. Malti: l-Erbgħa, 9 ta' Settembru, 2026;

ii. Ingliż: il-Ħamis, 10 ta' Settembru, 2026;

iii. Matematika: il-Ġimgħa, 11 ta' Settembru, 2026

Id-dati huma suġġetti għal tibdil. Il-kandidati jiġu infurmati għaxart (10) ijiem tax-xogħol bil-quddiem mid-data tal-eżami f'kull każ.

c. Eżempji tal-karti tal-eżami u past papers jistgħu jiġu aċċessati mis-sit elettroniku (<https://myexams.gov.mt/afm-past-papers-marking-schemes/>)

a. The AFM may consider engaging applicants who fail to achieve the qualification requirements specified in section 2.2. above, however these requirements must be obtained in order to progress through the ranks.

b. Personnel who do not meet the qualification requirements specified in section 2.2. above, will not be eligible for promotion until they successfully attain them.

c. Priority shall be given to applicants who meet requirements specified in section 2.2. of this call.

3. Vetting and Verification (required qualification, certificates, recognition where applicable)

Applicants must provide clear scanned copies of all certificates and all pages of transcripts requested, including MQF Level statement where applicable. For equivalence of qualifications, refer to paragraph 9.4 (a) to (e).

### 3.1 Written Examination (where applicable)

a. This part applies only to applicants who do not meet the required qualifications and must sit for the written exam/s as per eligibility requirements.

The written examinations are:

i. conducted by the Registrar of Examinations and the Board of Local Public Examinations;

ii. in a multiple choice format;

iii. allocated one hour and a half for each paper.

Each paper carries a maximum of 100 marks, whilst the pass mark in each of the papers is 50 marks.

Non-scientific calculators are allowed during the Mathematics examination.

b. Dates:

i. Maltese: Wednesday, 9th September, 2026;

ii. English: Thursday, 10th September, 2026;

iii. Mathematics: Friday, 11th September, 2026

Dates are subject to change. In all cases, however, candidates will be informed ten (10) working days in advance of the date of the examination.

d. Is-sillabi tal-eżamijiet tal-kitba jistgħu jiġu aċċessati mis-sit elettroniku (<https://myexams.gov.mt/local-public-examinations/>)

e. Ir-riżultati tal-eżami/jiet tal-kitba jintbagħtu permezz ta' ittra elettronika. Jekk jingħata numru tal-mowbajl validu, tintbagħat ukoll notifika SMS bħala kortesija.

f. L-applikanti jistgħu jitolbu reviżjoni tal-karta/i mhux aktar tard minn hamest (5) ijiem tax-xogħol mid-data tal-ħruġ tar-riżultati.

Nota importanti: Il-marki miksuba f'din il-parti ma jiġux ikkunsidrati fl-ordni tal-mertu finali.

#### 4. Il-Proċess tal-Għażla

IMPORTANTI: Applikanti li, għal kwalunkwe raġuni, jonqsu milli jattendu jew ilestu xi parti mill-Proċess tal-Għażla jitqiesu li rtiraw l-applikazzjoni tagħhom.

Applikanti li jinstabu li ma jissodisfawx ir-rekwiżiti ta' eliġibbiltà fi kwalunkwe hin ma jithallewx ikomplu u r-riżultati tagħhom jiġu annullati.

4.1 Parti I – Skrutinju (Fedina Penali u Verifika tar-Rekord Kriminali)

a. L-applikanti għandhom ikunu ta' karattru morali tajjeb;

b. Il-verifika isir skont il-politiki tal-FAM;

c. Il-FAM jirriżervaw d-dritt li jannullaw ir-riżultati ta' kwalunkwe kandidat li jirnexxi, jekk jinstab li għandu rekord kriminali mhux aċċettabbli, jew jekk ikun gie mkeċċi mill-FAM jew minn xi forza dikkjistrata oħra.

4.2 Parti II – Test ta' Effiċjenza Fiżika

a. L-applikanti jiġu ċċekkjati għall-għoli biex jiġi żgurat li jissodisfaw l-istandards meħtieġa.

b. Standards minimi:

i. Ġirja ta' mil: irġiel: mhux aktar minn 8 minuti u 30 sekonda; nisa: mhux aktar minn 10 minuti u 18-il sekonda

ii. Push-ups (2 minuti): irġiel: minimu 30; nisa: minimu 11

iii. Sit-ups (2 minuti): irġiel: minimu 37; nisa: minimu 35

c. L-applikanti jridu jilħqu l-istandard minimu f'kull parti biex jgħaddu.

d. The syllabi for the written examinations can be viewed by accessing the following link (<https://myexams.gov.mt/local-public-examinations/>)

e. Results of the written examination/s are sent by email. If a valid mobile number is provided, a courtesy SMS notification is sent.

f. Applicants may request a revision of paper/s not later than five (5) working days from the date of issue of results.

Important note: Marks obtained in this part will not be taken into consideration in the final order of merit.

#### 4. Selection Process

IMPORTANT: Applicants who, for any reason, fail to attend or complete any part of the Selection Process will be considered to have withdrawn their application.

Applicants found not to fulfil eligibility requirements at any time will not be allowed to proceed and will have their results annulled.

4.1 Part I – Vetting (Fedina Penali and Criminal Record Verification)

a. Applicants must be of good moral character;

b. Vetting will be in accordance with AFM policies;

c. AFM reserves the right to annul the result of any successful candidate if found to have an unacceptable criminal record, or has been dismissed from AFM or any disciplined force.

4.2 Part II – Physical Efficiency Test

a. Applicants will be checked for height to ensure they meet the required standards.

b. Minimum standards:

i. 1 mile run: males: not more than 8 minutes 30 seconds; females: not more than 10 minutes 18 seconds

ii. Push-ups (2 minutes): males: minimum 30; females: minimum 11

iii. Sit-ups (2 minutes): males: minimum 37; females: minimum 35

c. Applicants must attain the minimum standard in each part to pass.

## d. Regola ta' re-sit:

L-applikanti li ma jghaddux minn parti wahda tat-test fiziku, ikunu jistghu jergghu ipoġġu għal re-sit ta' dak it-test wiehed partikolari, fi żmien mhux inqas minn għaxart (10) ijiem wara li jkun sar l-ewwel test komplut, iżda fil-każ li jghaddu minn dan ir-re-sit xorta ma jkunux intitolati għal iżjed mill-marka minima ta' 150, irrappetitivament mill-marki miksubin fit-testijiet fiżiċi l-oħra.

## 4.3 Parti III – Intervista

a. L-applikanti jridu jiksibu minimu ta' 150 punt minn 300 biex jiġu kkunsidrati aktar.

b. Ir-riżultat huwa finali.

c. Punti għal kwalifiki addizzjonali:

i. Livell 7 tal-MQF: 40 punt għal kull suġġett

ii. Livell 6 tal-MQF: 30 punt għal kull suġġett

iii. Livell 5 tal-MQF: 20 punt għal kull suġġett

iv. Livell 4 tal-MQF: 15-il punt għal kull suġġett

v. Livell 3 tal-MQF: 10 punti għal kull suġġett

vi. Livell 2 tal-MQF: 5 punti għal kull suġġett

Dawn il-punti jingħataw għall-kwalifiki ADDIZZJONALI u mhux għar-rekwiżiti bażiċi u jingħaddu lejn l-Ordni ta' Mertu.

## 4.4 Parti IV – Test Militari

a. Din il-parti tagħti lill-applikanti indikazzjoni tat-taħriġ militari u jekk humiex adattati għall-ħajja militari u d-dixxiplina.

b. L-applikanti jridu jattendu numru ta' eżerċizzji ta' natura militari li jinkludu drill bażiku u attivitajiet ta' tim.

c. Din is-sezzjoni hija Pass jew Fail.

d. L-applikanti li, għal xi raġuni, ma jtemmex b'suċċess din il-parti għandhom jitqiesu li wehlu mill-Proċess tal-Għażla.

e. L-applikanti li juru, lejn il-persunal li qed jagħti direzzjoni jew applikanti oħra, kwalunkwe forma ta' mġiba li tkun għad-detriment tal-bon ordni u d-dixxiplina militari għandhom jitqiesu li wehlu mill-Proċess tal-Għażla.

## 4.5 Parti V – Eżami Mediku

## d. Re-sit rule:

Applicants who fail in one feat of the physical test only may re-sit that one event not less than ten (10) days following the first complete test, but in the case they are successful, they will only be entitled to the minimum pass mark of 150 regardless of other scores obtained in the other physical tests.

## 4.3 Part III – Interview

a. Applicants must obtain a minimum of 150 points out of 300 to be considered further.

b. The result is final.

c. Additional qualifications points:

i. MQF Level 7: 40 points per subject

ii. MQF Level 6: 30 points per subject

iii. MQF Level 5: 20 points per subject

iv. MQF Level 4: 15 points per subject

v. MQF Level 3: 10 points per subject

vi. MQF Level 2: 5 points per subject

These points are given to ADDITIONAL qualifications not the basic requirements and count towards the Order of Merit

## 4.4 Part IV – Military Test

a. This part gives applicants an indication of army training and whether they are suitable for military life and discipline.

b. Applicants must attend a number of exercises of a military nature which include basic drill and team activities.

c. This section is Pass or Fail

d. Applicants who fail, for any reason, to complete this part shall be deemed to have failed the Selection Process.

e. Any behaviour towards directing staff or other applicants that is detrimental to good order and military discipline shall result in failure of the Selection Process.

## 4.5 Part V – Medical Examination

a. L-applikanti jiġu eżaminati medikament biex jiġi żgurat li huma b'saħħithom għall-impjeg skont l-istandards tal-Forzi Regolari.

b. Aktar informazzjoni dwar l-istandards hija disponibbli fuq talba formali.

c. Il-valutazzjoni tal-Uffiċjali Medici tal-FAM hija finali u konkluziva.

d. L-applikanti jagħtu l-kunsens tagħhom lill-Uffiċjali Medici tal-FAM biex f'kull hin sakemm ikunu għadhom fis-servizz, dawn ikunu jistgħu jitolbu dokumenti mediċi personali minn kwalunkwe sptar tal-Gvern u privat.

e. Kwalunkwe irregolarità u/jew diskrepanza tista' tiġi rreferita mill-imsemmijin Uffiċjali Medici lill-Uffiċjali tal-Forzi Armati ta' Malta kif meqjus xieraq.

### 5. Ordni ta' Mertu

a. Il-vakanzi jimtlew skont l-ordni ta' mertu finali relatata ma' din is-sejha.

b. Il-validità tal-ordni ta' mertu finali tiskadi wara sitt xhur mill-pubblikazzjoni tar-riżultat finali.

c. L-ordni ta' mertu finali tiġi ddeterminata mit-total ta' punti miksuba kif ġej:

i. Test ta' Effiċjenza Fiziċa: massimu 300, minimu 150

ii. Intervista: massimu 300, minimu 150 (massimu addizzjonali ta' 100 punt għal kwalifiki addizzjonali, sakemm l-applikant jikseb mill-inqas 150 marka fl-intervista)

d. B'referenza għal paragrafu 3.2, persunal li ma jissodisfax ir-rekwiżiti ta' kwalifiki msemmija f'taqsima 2.2. hawn fuq, jitqiegħed wara dawk li jissodisfawhom fl-Ordni ta' Mertu (OOM).

### 6. Skeda u Kordinazzjoni tal-Proċess tal-Għażla

Il-Verifika u l-Validazzjoni tal-applikazzjonijiet u l-Eżamijiet bil-Kitba jitmexxew mid-Dipartiment tal-Eżamijiet filwaqt li Parti I sa Parti V jitmexxew mill-FAM.

a. Il-Verifika u l-Validazzjoni tal-applikazzjonijiet jitlestew wara d-data tal-gheluq ta' din is-sejha għall-applikazzjonijiet.

b. L-Eżami/jiet tal-Kitba jsir/u kif indikat fil-paragrafu 3.2, b, i, ii u iii.

c. Parti I – Skrutinju tal-FAM issir ladarba l-eżamijiet ikunu ġew konkluzi.

a. Applicants will be medically examined to confirm fitness according to Regular Force standards.

b. Further information on standards is available upon formal request.

c. The AFM Medical Officers' assessment is final and conclusive.

d. Applicants consent to AFM Medical Officers retrieving personal medical records from Government and private hospitals until officially discharged from service.

e. Any irregularity and/or discrepancy may be transmitted to appropriate Officers within AFM.

### 5. Order of Merit

a. Vacancies will be filled according to the final order of merit pertaining to this call.

b. The validity of the final order of merit expires after six months from publication of the final result.

c. The final order of merit is determined by the total points gained as follows:

i. Physical Efficiency Test: max. 300, min. 150

ii. Interview: max. 300, min. 150 (additional max. 100 points for additional qualifications, provided the applicant obtains at least 150 marks in the interview)

d. Reference to para 3.2 personnel who do not meet the qualifications requirements specified in section 2.2. above, will be placed after those who do in the OOM

### 6. Selection process Timeline and Coordination

Vetting and Verification of applications and the Written Examinations are conducted by the Department of Examinations while Part I to Part V of the Selection Process are conducted by the AFM.

a. Vetting and Verification of applications will be completed following the closing date of this call for applications.

b. The Written Examination/s will be conducted as indicated in para 3.2, b, i, ii & iii.

c. Part I – AFM Vetting will take place once the examinations have been concluded.

d. Parti II, Parti III u Parti V flimkien ma' screening mediku preliminarj jkunu fl-istess gurnata lejn l-aħħar ta' Ottubru u Novembru. Kandidati li jirnexxu jintalbu jattendu gurnata oħra f'Ottubru, Novembru jew Diċembru biex iwettqu Parti V tal-Proċess tal-Għażla.

Il-kors tat-taħriġ bażiku huwa skedat li jibda f'Jannar 2027.

## 7. Ingagġ u Taħriġ

a. Il-kandidati magħżula jkunu meħtieġa jgħaddu minn Test Preparatorju ta' Effiċjenza Fizika qabel jiġu ingagġati biex jiġi żgurat li jkunu għadhom fizikament f'saħħithom skont l-istandards tal-Forza Regolari.

b. Ikunu jridu jagħmlu taħriġ bażiku għal perijodu ta' mhux aktar minn hames (5) xhur.

c. Rekluti jiġu rilaxxati mis-Servizz jekk ma jilhqax il-livell meħtieġ.

d. Rekluti li jlestu t-taħriġ b'suċċess jiġu kkonfermati fil-grad ta' Gunner u mqassma fir-Riġmenti skont il-htigiet tas-Servizz.

e. Rekluti li jgarrbu korrimenti waqt it-taħriġ bażiku u li minhabba fihom ma jkunux jistgħux jilhqax l-istandards meħtieġa jiġu rilaxxati mis-servizz.

The Food Safety and Security Authority (FSSA) notifies that, in exercise of its functions under the Pesticides Control Act (Cap. 430) and pursuant to Regulation 4(3) of the Sustainable Use of Pesticides Regulations (S.L. 430.08), is extending the validity of all Plant Protection Products (PPP) professional user certificates and distributor certificates which have expired or are due to expire on or before 30th September, 2026.

Accordingly, any such PPP professional user certificates or distributor certificates that expire on or before 30th September, 2026, shall be deemed to remain valid until 1st June, 2027.
